Please accept this letter of support from Uu-a-thluk (Nuu-chah-nulth Tribal Council Fisheries) for the Hesquiaht First Nation Fisheries' project entitled 'Integrating fisheries culture into the local elementary school curriculum'.

Part of the mandate of my position is to encourage the revitalization and continuation of traditional Nuuchahnulth fisheries culture. Fishing was, until relatively recently, the lifeblood of communities such as Hesquiaht. In more recent years however, many fishers have ceased to fish due to age or other social factors. And yet these fishers have a wealth of knowledge to pass on to younger generations. Meanwhile, the combined kindergarten to grade 7 class have been enthusiastic to welcome guests into the classroom to share traditions and culture, or to venture out into the field to investigate the natural environment and learn about the professions of their community members. Other guest presentations from the RES or myself as a biologist will enhance the experience and increase exposure to ecological issues. I believe that this project will be beneficial to the entire community, and look forward to working with fishers to develop their presentation and preparation skills.
