a. Introduction to your organization:

THE TONQUIN FOUNDATION IS A LOCALLY-BASED HERITAGE ORGANIZATION FORMED IN 2003 AND DEDICATED TO THE CONSERVATION, INTERPRETATION + PROMOTION OF THE HERITAGE RESOURCES OF CLAYOQUOT SOUND. THE FOUNDATION ENGAGES IN MARINE AND TERRESTRIAL ARCHAEOLOGY, HISTORICAL RESEARCH, MUSEUM SCIENCE, ARTIFACT CONSERVATION + PROGRAMMES OF PUBLIC EDUCATION + INTERPRETATION. THE FOUNDATION IS A REGISTERED NON PROFIT SOCIETY UNDER THE SOCIETIES ACT OF BRITISH COLUMBIA AND A REGISTERED CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION UNDER REVENUE CANADA'S CHARITY ACT.

b. Tell us about your project. Include a description, goals and a timeline for completion:

THE MORPHEUS ISLAND CEMETERY MIGHT TRULY BE TERMED TORINO'S "PIONEER CEMETERY" AS LAID TO REST THERE ARE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE REGION'S "FIRST SETTLER FAMILIES", AS WELL AS MEMBER'S OF THE REGION'S ONCE VIBRANT JAPANESE + CHINESE COMMUNITIES. IN RECENT YEARS THE CEMETERY HAS BEEN ALLOWED TO DETERIORATE GENERALLY, WITH SOME SPECIFIC PLOTS REQUIRING TIMELY REMEDIATION IF THEY ARE TO SURVIVE AS MARKERS TO <sup>THE</sup> AREA'S PIONEER PAST. THE FOUNDATION PROPOSES TO REMEDIATE THE SITE GENERALLY, GIVING SPECIAL ATTENTION TO "THREATENED" GRAVE PLOTS, INSTALL MARKED WALKWAYS THROUGHOUT THE SITE, AS WELL AS INSTALL INTERPRETIVE SIGNAGE AT THE CEMETERY'S ENTRANCE PROVIDING DETAILS OF THE LIVES OF THOSE WHO ARE LAID TO REST THERE. VEGETATION THAT HAS INUNDATED PORTIONS OF THE SITE WILL BE REMOVED, AS WILL BE "SNAGGED" TREES + DEADFALLS THAT PREVENT EASE OF ACCESS TO THE LANDING BEACH. REGULAR MONITORING, MAINTENANCE + UPKEEP WILL BE UNDERTAKEN OVER THE LONG TERM. EFFORTS WILL BE MADE TO ENGAGE THE COMMUNITY AS A WHOLE IN IMPRESSING THEM (+VISITORS ALIKE) WITH THE CULTURAL SIGNIFICANCE OF THIS HERITAGE CEMETERY. SCHOOL GROUPS, TOUR GROUPS + OTHERS WILL BE ENCOURAGED TO VISIT THE SITE ON AN ONGOING BASIS, IN ORDER TO BETTER UNDERSTAND + APPRECIATE THIS RARE + FRAGILE HERITAGE RESOURCE.
