We intend to publish a history of the church in Tofino, of the building itself, its association with the church in Portsea, England which raised funds; the various ministers; members of the congregation and those who have chosen this church for family celebrations.

As this is the only historic building in Tofino, our project will raise awareness of the history of Tofino for both residents and tourists.

Our upcoming centennial in 2013 was the driving force which inspired this project. All members of the ACW are involved in all decisions regarding this centennial project which will be done to the highest professional standard with a local author writing the text and a qualified designer planning the layout in preparation for publishing. A small committee from our members will be struck to edit the material.

We intend to market the book to the tourists, now numbering one and a half million per year, also former and present members of our congregation. Success will be measured in how well the book sells.

We will be receiving some funding from the District of Tofino as our normal fund-raising activities only support our social outreach e.g. the Food Bank; a local cancer victim; Christmas Angels and any other activities which we agree to support.

As already stated we are also heavily involved in the maintenance of the church from our fund-raising efforts. e.g. April/May Community Afternoon Tea and Fashion Show involving local merchants and with no charge for tea; June Village Garage Sale; November Christmas Bazaar. We are few in number and, despite our enthusiasm, are unable to undertake any further fund-raising to fund publication of the St. Columba history.
